In light of this, we are implementing this Cyber Policy to provide clear expectations for online conduct and to ensure that our digital community aligns with the principles of respect, compassion, and kindness that we uphold.

Purpose:

The purpose of this Cyber Policy is to establish clear guidelines and expectations for student behavior in online environments, particularly regarding the use of social media. Veritas Collegiate Academy is committed to providing a safe and supportive educational environment, and this policy aims to foster a respectful digital community.

Scope:

This policy applies to all students at Veritas Collegiate Academy and covers all forms of digital communication, including social media platforms, email, texting, and other online interactions, both on and off campus.
